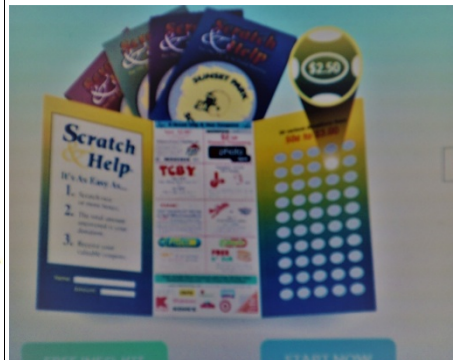
- You can earn money. Who doesn’t need that, right?

Option #1

Bee Club Work Booklet

Working Bees will earn money by serving others. Bees will need to purchase a Bee Club booklet from www.MyCfun.org with parent's permission and help. Click on "**Donate**" button. Where it says "Add special instructions to the seller", you or your parent should type in "Bee Club". Booklets cost \$21.00 and will earn up to 90% profit if someone helps you purchase your booklet. If you work hard doing odd jobs and chores for family members, relatives, friends and church members, you could earn approximately \$79.00 after you repay the person who helped you. Make sure you pay back whoever loans you the money to purchase your booklet. You can serve others by washing dishes, dusting, raking leaves, vacuuming floors or other needed household duties. You could rack in some good money. Only work for people you or someone in your family is familiar with for safety reasons. See instructions for this booklet on the next page.

Instructions

>Purchase our Project 21 Scratch Card from www.MyCfun.org. Click on “donate” button to make payment. Where it says “Add special instructions to the seller”, you or your parent should type in Bee Club. Booklets cost \$21.00.

>Explain to your child that he/she will be doing chores for your family and others to earn money (washing dishes, cleaning up, raking leaves, dusting, vacuuming, sweeping floors or other duties). There are so many jobs your child can do to help you or other family members, relatives and close friends.

>You and your child should discuss fair prices for these duties and then allow employers to scratch off several dots to add up negotiated pay. After child receives pay for work, the child will be able to give a discount coupon to the employer as an incentive to be contacted again. Know whose house your child is visiting for safety reasons. Stress the importance of always doing a great job and encourage your child to save some of his/her money.

>Parents, it’s very important if you loaned your child \$21.00 to purchase a booklet, make sure he/she pays you back. After repaying you, your child should have a profit of \$79.00 that he/she worked to earn. Parent’s your cost will be “0 dollars”. Be proud!!! 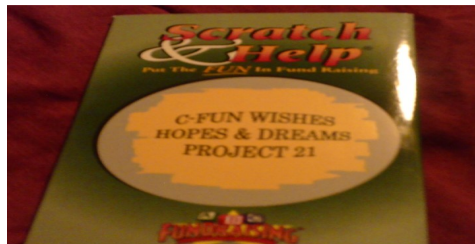
